The Sheriff's Office is committed to community partnerships and the ongoing development of problem solving initiatives. Neighborhood Watch is one program that exemplifies the very best of these principles, with citizens and law enforcement working together.

In order to provide continued communication and enhance the effectiveness of Neighborhood Watch, the sheriff's office has established a new method of information sharing. The Sheriff's Citizen Notification system will provide immediate dissemination of information, not only to Neighborhood Watch block Captains, but to every registered participant. Information concerning recent crime trends, seasonal crime tips, a quarterly newsletter, and upcoming community events will be shared regularly through e-mail advisories.

In addition, individuals or communities once discouraged by national participation standards can participate in our program right away. This benefits the sheriff's office and community directly by increasing awareness to a larger number of citizens. Communities reaching 75% participation will be entitled to Neighborhood Watch signs within their subdivisions at no cost.
